



**OFFICIAL STATEMENT  
STUDENTS PHYSICAL ADMISSION TO CAMPUS ON SEMESTER I  
ACADEMIC SESSION 2021/2022**

1. According to the Official Statement of the Ministry of Higher Education dated 14 September 2021 which allows students to return to campus in stages beginning 15 October 2021, Universiti Malaysia Pahang (UMP) has agreed that some categories of students will be allowed to physically return to the university to undergo hybrid (online and face-to-face) teaching and learning activities as follows:

**14. Students from Categories 1 to 12 who require university transportation services** (Based on student confirmation to be made after the student fills in the information in the JHEP system)

2. Students in all the above categories are required to come to the campus to participate in hybrid teaching and learning activities (online and face-to-face). **Failure to return to the campus that could affect academic performance and student graduation is the responsibility of the student.**
3. It is **COMPULSORY** for students to confirm their return through <https://community.ump.edu.my>> **Sistem Pulang Ke Kampus** that will be **opened starting 20 until 30 September 2021** for the purpose of coordinating the admission to the university. **Interstate Authorisation Letter** can be downloaded via the same link once the students finished:
  - i. Updating student vaccine status,
  - ii. Confirming the return,
  - iii. Selecting slot for health screening purposes,
  - iv. Choosing the transportation mode to return to the campus, and

- v. Updating parents/guardian vaccine status if they choose to return to the campus with a parents/guardian vehicle.
4. All students who are required to return to the campus are also **COMPULSORY** to:
- i. Stay at Student Residents provided to create a campus bubble cluster.
  - ii. Complete vaccination, receiving two doses that passes the 14th day after the second dose injection (Pfizer, AstraZeneca and Sinovac vaccines). Meanwhile, the recipients of the one-dose vaccination (Johnson & Johnson and CanSino) should pass the 28th day after the injection date.
5. In line with this official statement, the announcement of the 13th administration and operation of student management, No. 13/2021 regarding the offer of student accommodation in Student Residents for the Academic Session 2021/2022 is **VOID**.
6. This announcement also applies to the **existing students** on campus.
